

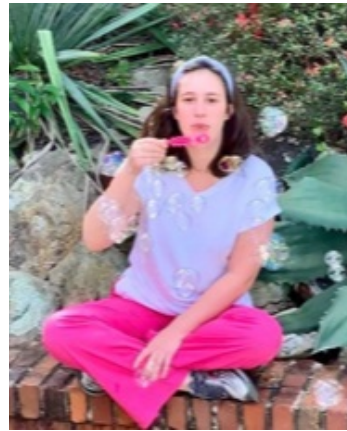


Where We Are Now - since March 16th
